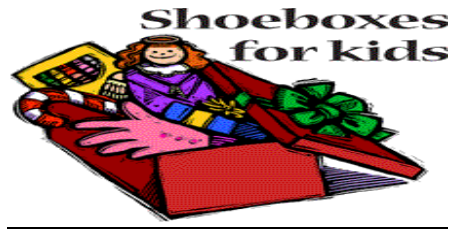
Working
