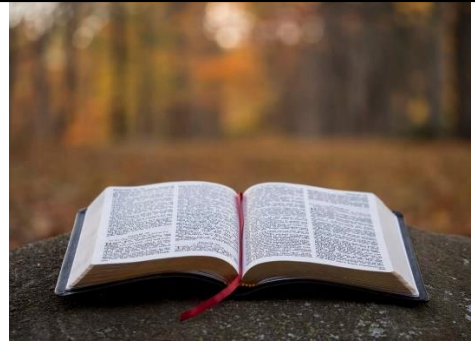
We also have several individual cans of pop various flavors at \$.35 a can.
