

As I focused on my partner's eyes, I relaxed as he guided me through each step. By pressing my back, he led me forward, and with a slight push on my palm, he eased me into a backward step. My steps fell into perfect sync with his.

My walk with God is just like dancing. Focusing on myself only causes me to stumble. Instead of worrying about what will come next, I simply need to look up, trusting the Holy Spirit to guide me into each next step. When we keep our eyes on Jesus and relax in His embrace, our steps will fall into perfect sync with His, and our dance will become a beautifully choreographed testimony of God's care provision.
