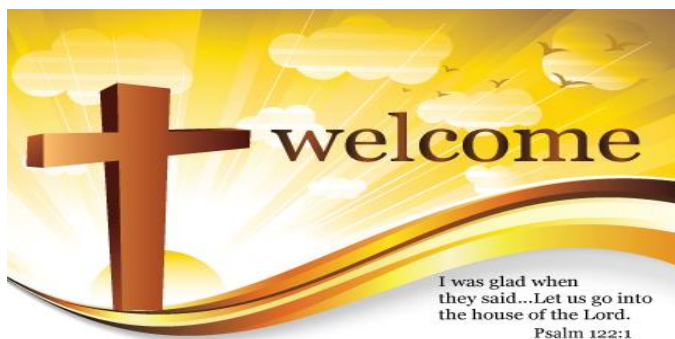
Good Morning everyone! David wrote, "I was glad

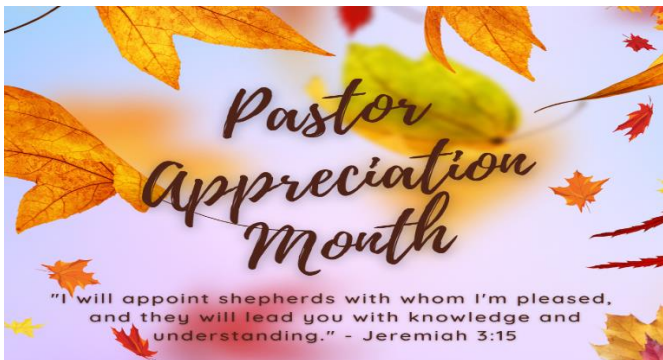
